To Whom it May Concern:

This letter is on behalf of my patient, Landon James Schultz, DOB: . Landon will be traveling with his family at times and is diagnosed with a rare disorder, Food Protein-Induced Enterocolitis Syndrome (FPIES). FPIES is a severe food allergy of the gastrointestinal system that causes delayed reactions of profuse vomiting, bloody stools and may led to hypovolemic shock. Landon must avoid all foods that cause this reaction to ensure his safety.

Landon current has limited diet and specific foods that he is able to tolerate: turkey, peppers, peas, white potato, strawberry, blueberry, banana, almond, cocoa, oat, apple, watermelon, salmon, avocado. These foods must travel with Landon at all times. If these foods are unavailable to Landon, he will not have any other options for his nutritional and dietary needs and many of these foods are not available on the island of Eleuthera. I am requesting that Landon be allowed to travel with these items on board during his trip to the Bahamas. It is imperative that he have these items, Should he loose these foods, he will not be able to supplement them.

Landon also requires a medical amino acid based elemental formula called EO28 Splash, Neocate Nutra and Elecare. He will be traveling with large quantities of this formula to maintain hydration, meet his medical and nutritional needs and to avoid potential reactions. I am requesting that Landon be allowed to travel with these items, on board, during his travels to Bahamas. Should he loose these items, he will not be able to supplement them. It is imperative that he have this formula with him at all times.

Landon also requires the following medications: Prevacid solu-tabs, Zyrtec liquid, Flovent inhaler, Xopenex nebulizer treatments, Benadryl (liquid and pill form) Epinephrine (Epi-Pen), Hydrocortisone cream, Tylenol and Prednisone. It is important that these medications remain with Landon at all times during his travel and vacation. Additional information may be obtained from us at our Philadelphia Allergy location.
